## OUR MISSION

#### **PASTOR'S MESSAGE**

Advent is a time of preparation and expectation. The Church describes Advent as a season "of devout and expectant delight." In Universal Norms on the Liturgical Year, the Church says, "Advent has a twofold character, for it is a time of preparation for the Solemnities of Christmas, in which the First Coming of the Son of God to humanity is remembered, and likewise a time when, with remembrance of this, minds and hearts are led to look forward to Christ's Second Coming at the end of time" (39). In Advent, we look forward not only to the commemoration of Christ's birth at Christmas, but also to His return. Pope Francis described Advent as the time "we begin again and it returns us to the horizon of hope, a hope that does not disappoint because it is founded on the Word of God. A hope that does not disappoint, simply because the Lord never disappoints! He is faithful." Prepare for a good confession during Advent season. The Church calls us to repentance during Advent, making it an important time to go to confession. Perhaps getting yourself and your family to confession can be your top priority this Advent. Ask God to help us draw near to Him. The more we yearn for Christ in Advent, the closer we come to a real celebration of Christmas. Deep down inside, we know that we have a chance for transformation during Advent—but we often forget to ask for it in prayer. Let us ask God to help us prepare our hearts for His coming and to aid us in having a good and holy Advent. After all, it is what He longs for us to do.
