This is my first quarterly report for the new fiscal year 22-23. Looking over the Sunday income, the numbers are right in line with budget. This quarter should be at 25% of income and are slightly higher at 26.47% with a collection figure of \$173,086. As for Operating Expenses, they are under budget at \$145,959 which is at 20.12%. Capital Expenditures are at 25.12% and is made up of the following items. The first two stained glass windows were commissioned and the deposit of \$7,870 was paid from donations from several parishioners. They will hopefully be installed late October or early November. The deposit for the lower roof to be replaced was made in September which was budgeted for and covered by our Cost & Replacement Savings. The stands for the outdoor Stations of the Cross located around the exterior of our property were covered by our Gifts & Bequest Savings. You may have noticed we have new chairs in the choir, Baptismal, and handicap areas. Funds were designated in the Cost & Replacement Savings for these and the balance was covered by excess funds received from the Valentine Dance and Ladies Candlelight, along with funds from the sale of the old chairs. The Pavilion is almost complete with the installation this month of the heaters. We have all been enjoying the benefits of having the Pavilion with our outdoor Mass and various functions held under the roof. Deep gratitude to all those who have generously donated to the Pavilion and continue to do so which will help with the cost of the heat installation. Come January, the Finance Committee will be changing the Focus Giving Envelope to be for additional stained glass windows. Photos of the windows in progress can be found on our website. We had the opportunity to go to the studio and see the design and I have to say, the detail in the faces, wood, leaves, etc is amazing. I cannot wait to see the finished product. People have been emailing or calling asking about donating towards the cost. While the price may increase for future windows, we were able to lock in a price of \$20K each for the first two windows. This cost is higher than the Holy Spirit circle window due to all of the colors, as well as the independent artist hired to sketch, design and paint the glass. If you are interested in donating towards a window, either partially or fully, please contact me.

The annual summer festival was held in August this year. Thanks to Jeff Sommer for chairing Spiritfest. Everyone seemed to enjoy the music, food, and camaraderie. Our profit for the two day event was \$14,437.87. It was nice to see so many faces from the community here at Holy Spirit and I would like to

thank our many volunteers who helped with the planning, set-up, tear-down, manning the booths and working double shifts. It is not possible to run an event like this without all of you!

Thanks to all who have been supporting our Benevolence Fund. The funds have helped so many people in need this past fiscal year (July 2021 – June 2022) in the amount of \$8,829.67. The generosity of Holy Spirit Parishioners allows us to help those in need; what a blessing.

Thank you to all who have been either dropping in the collection basket, at the office or mailing in their Redner Receipts. From July 2021 through June 2022, we have received \$1,525.98.
