Group Discussion:

- 1) What part of the reading stood out most for you this week?
- 2) Describe the Professor's house. How do you think the children felt being in a new place far from their parents? How would you feel?
- 3) If you found the wardrobe and wandered into Narnia what would you have done?
- 4) Describe Mr. Tumnus. What are your first thoughts about him? Would you have accepted his invitation to his home?
- 5) If you were Peter or Susan would you have believed Lucy when she came back from Narnia? Why or why not?
- 6) What did the White Witch offer Edmund? Why do you think she offered it to him?
- 7) Why do you think the White Witch wants Edmund to return with his brother and sisters? Why is she asking him to keep it a secret?
- 8) Why do you think it's difficult for Edmund to apologize to Lucy for not believing her?
- 9) If you were Lucy, would you want to go back to Narnia? What about if you were Edmund?

Reflection Questions:

- 1) What are some ways to stay joyful and hopeful in times when you are upset?
- 2) What character do you think you are most like?
- 3) Is there a mistake you keep making that is difficult to make right again? How might you keep working to make it better?
