Feb Meeting Minutes: Motion to Approve minutes made by Elizabeth with Pat seconding, all in favor pending corrections reflected below:

- Welcome and Introductions
 - o Introduce Lori Jasper, Parish Secretary
- Finance Report: Mark reported Net income \$48K vs budget of \$43,000. Fairly healthy. Sunday collections are \$409K vs \$385K so ahead by \$24K. Diocesan Annual Campaign (DAC) assessment was \$86K. Looking at \$14K shortfall. Debt balance is roughly \$20K as of March and as of this week is \$11.5K. 30 year mortgage paid off in 8 years. Budget approved for next year. Plan reserve steady; consultant to complete building assessment to determine estimated useful life and replacement cost. Financial report to be included in bulletin. Questions arose:
 - How do we incentivize parishioners who were paying down the debt? Something for parishioners who like to support parish initiatives
 - We can drive focus toward DAC due to potential shortfall or shift toward request for funds for organ.
 - The committee liked idea for specific restricted donation offerings
 - Letter for organ, council supports idea. Organ allows pipes, digital organ with good speakers. \$70K. We could keep a rolling restricted donation.
 - Council agrees with having a restricted donation for specific items, as parishioners like to support local parish goals

New Business

- Mass Intentions Proposal
 - Open it up for 1 year. We are almost completely full for mass requests. Weekends are full a year out. Father Wayne is going to be a pastor so we will not have that outlet. Walked thru current process and how new proposal could work.
 - Refer to proposal
 - Open Mass book three times throughout year because it allows flexibility.
 - How do we limit someone requesting 15+ requests? Explain why we have this policy and limit it.

- Can/should we limit # of requests. Create a spreadsheet to manage this. Offered suggestion for allowing 2 to be booked per month.
- Problem: we could have one person come in and say I want 6 masses for Sunday at 8:30 AM.
- We need the flexibility to allow for special circumstances. Walked through examples.
- Who supports proposal #2, walked thru specifics.
 - Open mass book in phases
 - 2 specific mass dates can be requested per calendar year to one weekend and weekday
 - Unlimited mass intentions and filled in for availability
 - If death or anniversary for multiple of 2 sent out to sister parish
 - We will not list requestor name
 - When parishioner dies, block off 1 year for anniversary. Counts as 1 of 2 requests.
 - Effective October 2019 Mass Book Opening
 - Post in bulletin
- Explain understanding in bulletin/policy
- Will family will still get Mass card? Confirmed.
- Motion: John made motion for modified proposal 2 and Pat seconded. Motion carriers

- Update on Construction
 - Completed confessionals, adult baptismal font, starting on infant baptismal font and 13th of May starting on renovation of Adoration Chapel.
 - Only other projects are filling in with chairs at baptismal font, cut out niche
 where we walk into church and put in candles/votive, looking at room for
 infants/children. Pews donated from hospital to go into Adoration Chapel.
- Adoration Chapel Participation
 - Significantly better participation during lent.
 - Is the goal to get schedule filled? Father is bringing in Diane Bird to help Bart maintain it
 - In the back of Adoration Chapel there is an invitation to see what hours we
 do need to fill. How many adorers are coming? Have a meeting with all the
 adorers on May 19th. Little talk about Adoration and put together a

video/start a group for the adorers. Build rapport/ministry. Help them encourage others to come to Adoration Chapel. Training on how to tell your story about your experiences. Bring together 1 or 2 times per year

Preschool at Holy Spirit

- Determined that we will start a preschool but not till Sept 2020. Want to make sure we have everything lined up. Start a board for the preschool.
