Finance Report	<ul> <li>INCOME</li> <li>Sunday income is at 54%, which it should be at 50% for Dec so we are slightly over budget.</li> <li>Christmas Collection as of 12/31 is at \$21,722.60, which is at 98.74% of budget. We are confident we will surpass the budget figure as we are still receiving donations for the holiday.</li> <li>Total operating income is at \$473,385.37 which is 59.10% of budget so our income is remaining ahead of budget which is great.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>EXPENSES</li> <li>Total operating expenses are slightly under budget at 46.44%.</li> <li>We have been busy at Holy Spirit with the 2 new exterior doors off the sanctuary (both were paid by a donor). We also have the Pavilion up. We are waiting on the electricity, heating, and the shed for storage yet. We are grateful to all our parishioners who have continued to donate towards this project in the Focus Giving Envelopes. We had a total of 640 attend the outdoor Christmas Mass, which celebrated under the Pavilion.</li> </ul>

4. Synod on Synodology	<ul> <li>Definition - Susan spoke on this - the purpose of this is to start at the local level and then keep going up as high as the Vatican and there will be a synod that will occur in Rome in 2023. Traditionally, they have been for bishops and cardinals and occurred in Rome. They are basically held to set the direction for our church. Pope Francis is looking at a synod in a different approach - he wants to have all the Catholics who are baptized in the church to determine the direction in the church - "Walking together in the same path." He wants everyone to participate in this together. Get our thinking back to the beginning and how we have or have not found God through our Church. The Pope wants to listen to everyone including those who have left the church and those on the fence. He wants to also include children and grandchildren. He wants this to be a global effort.</li> <li>After these listening sessions are held, we will be gathering information and will send it to the Diocese of Harrisburg, Due May 1st (must be done very quickly. The Diocese has sent Sue a copy of the Vademecum, Official handbook for listening and discernment.</li> <li>The diocese also has a synodal support team (3 people available to us by phone or meeting).</li> <li>Sue has also talked to some of the other churches in the area to see what they are doing (sacred heart, SJA, etc) - everyone seems to be in the same place with initiation of the project.</li> <li>Possibly starting with a survey with reaching to as many people as we can (email or paper copies), maybe then focus groups and then at least one mandatory consultation session.</li> <li>Questions will be coming fromVademecum regarding questions in the surveys (Questions about how we find God. What have been the certain ways we have found God? How is this facilitating us finding God?)</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Encouraging to having the survey be as broad as possible.</li> <li>Making sure have someone facilitating the focus group to stay on task.</li> <li>Possibly generating a sample questionnaire/survey to send out</li> <li>The purpose of the synod - to document what conversations are happening at the local level (i.e., what works for us in how we are finding God).</li> <li>The diocese suggests that we provide surveys to ex Catholics.</li> <li>Example questions (How is this journeying together to find God?).</li> <li>The goal of this is to help increase the infrastructure so communication can happen more efficiently. (The Pope is trying to slowly restructure the infrastructure of the Church). Either way this will help locally</li> <li>Sue asked if there are people willing to help with Surveys, focus groups, leadership</li> </ul>
