2. Finance Report (Marc -presented by Janet)	• March we should be at 75% of our budget. Sunday income is at \$469,621.04 which is 78.81%.		
	• We budgeted \$15,000 for Easter and as of this past Sunday we have \$11,650.		
	• Fish Fry Income for March was \$43,262.20 – total income for Fish Fry was \$65,826.42. There were individuals that were giving substantial monetary tips for the event because they like it so much – some were non-parishioners. Fish Fry Expenses for March were \$18,028.90 with total Expenses for Fish Fry \$35,135.51. Our profit for FF was \$30,690.91		
	• Total Operating Income is at \$691,162.99 which is 86.28% of budget. Our income is remaining above budget.		
	• Expenses: Operating Expenses are below budget at \$513,774.87 which is 70.66%.		

	Capital Expenditures is over budget at \$159,852.71 which is 145.32%. Most of this overage was covered by private parishioner donations or withdraws from Cost & Replacement Savings. Pavilion we have been using the funds that come in each week to cover as many expenses as we can and then Cost & Replacement Savings for any additional. We just dug the trench and laid the gas line to get ready for next year's budgeted item, the heat for the pavilion. • Budget: The Finance Committee will be meeting to finalize the budget for 22/23 and we will submit it to the Diocese by the end of April.
3. Review/Edit/Approve January Minutes (Council)	 DAC DAC for 2022 is \$98,396. To date we have \$40,264 collected. We will be sending an email to all parishioners who we have email addresses for and will be talking about it from the pulpit. We budgeted for a shortfall Susan motioned to approve March meeting minutes and Rob seconded – motion approved.
4. Synod on Synodology	 Identified local characteristics that had the most positive influences – Journeying together is where our parish shines. Sharing of concerns and worries was imperative to Synodal process such as issues for teens or individuals who have left the church. Summarized our Town Hall, which centered around listening to testimonies. Most people were surprised that it was more about parishioners providing experiences and testimonies. Discussed focus group responses from teens. Discussed the possibility of future town halls. Perhaps establish an agenda for future town halls as well as generate future surveys to keep gathering information. Synodal directions for the dioceses were also presented during this meeting.
