

We are happy to announce the Holy Spirit Adoration Chapel reopened on Monday, June 15<sup>th</sup> for Adoration with our Lord! **The daily hours of operation are listed below.** These limited hours were selected so we can better manage the health of the space and secure adorers to fill the open hours. They are also scheduled around our current Mass times. These hours will be expanded based on the COVID-19 situation in the County as well as the availability of coverage to be with Jesus in the Chapel. We are monitoring the situation and will provide updates as they become available.

So how do we move forward? Review the following steps below. **Step 1.** Sign -up; **Step 2.** Review the Visiting Rules; **Step 3.** Note the contact information.

### **1. STEP 1: Sign-up**

We are seeking adorers to commit to our open hours. Hours are: Monday – Friday Noon – 4pm; Saturday 7pm – 10pm and Sunday Noon – 1pm & 6 – 9pm. **The only hour that currently needs filled in this schedule is 8 – 9pm on Saturday night. If you can help at this hour, contact us.** We will expand off these hours if adorers are available to cover. Please contact us if you are interested in committing to an hour prior to or at the end of our stated opening or closing times.

- In addition to the scheduled hour adorer, five other visitors can come into the Chapel during each hour it is open. Resulting in a total of 6 adorers at a time. **The 5 visitors do not have to sign-up with us as long as we have a secured adorer.** Visitors can come and go as they please, but please sign in the visiting book at the desk in the vestibule (bring a pen).

- If you arrive and there are already six people present in the Chapel, please wait for someone to leave OR come back at a later time.

### **2. Step 2: Review the Visiting Rules**

-When you enter the Chapel you must have a mask on. Masks must also be worn in the vestibule and not taken off until you reach the outdoors.

- Use hand sanitizer (located on the wall to your right as you enter the Chapel) when entering.

- Sit in a pew at a location marked with **GREEN TAPE**. They have been set at safe social distancing suggestions.

- When you are finished, spray your seat and all areas you touched with the provided cleaner (remember the kneeler). Wait three minutes, then wipe it with the provided rags.

- Use hand sanitizer as you exit the Chapel.

\* All books will be removed from the Chapel in advance of the opening. No shared documents.

\* The sign-in pen will be removed. Adorers are encouraged to bring your own to sign-in.

### **Rules**

\* Please avoid touching the statues, crucifix, monstrance, alter.

\* No large gatherings in the chapel for devotions at this time.

Please wait to visit if you:

Have any of the following symptoms:

\* Cold

\* Cough

\* Runny nose

\* Sore throat

\* Muscle aches

\* Fever

Have been in close proximity with anyone in the last 14 days who is:

- \* Currently sick with COVID-19
- \* Currently sick with any respiratory illness

If you have a compromised immune system or fall into a high risk category. Your health and safety is our number one concern.
